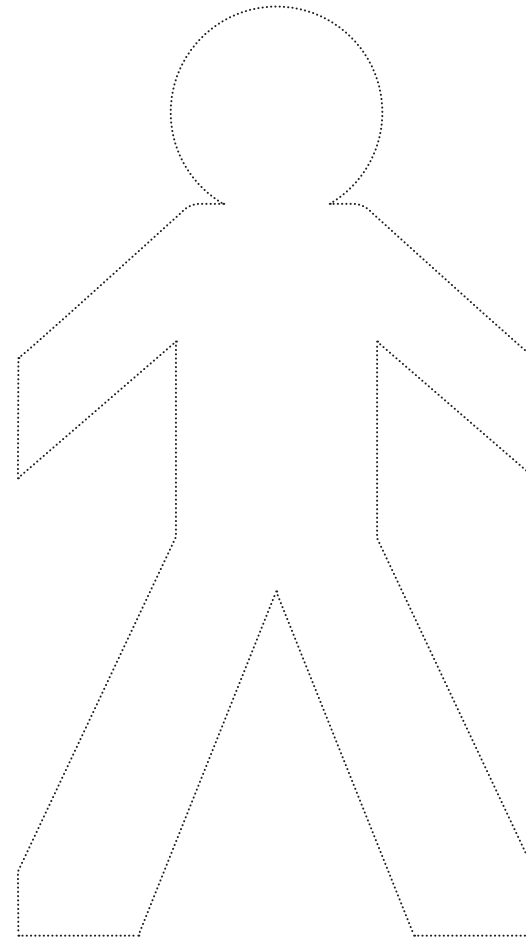
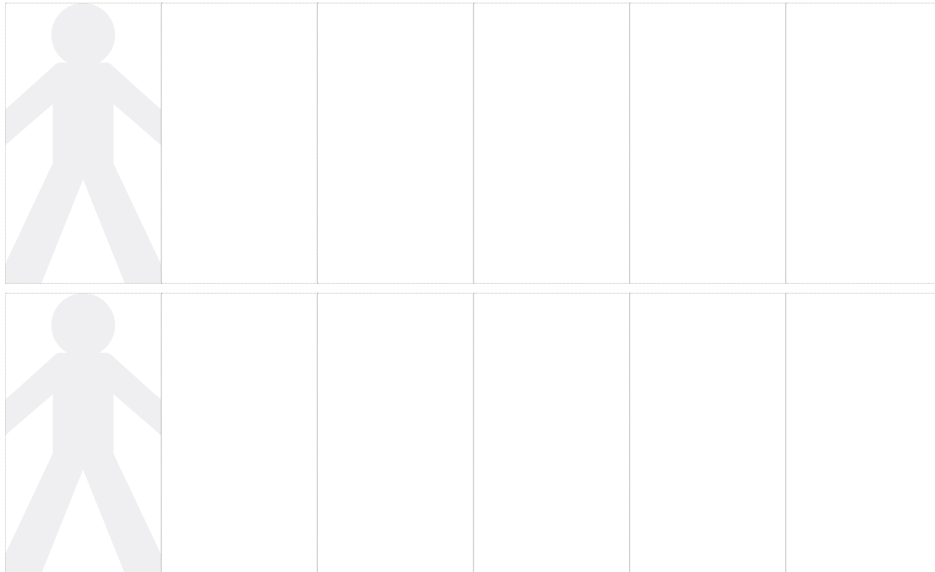


Child affirmation chain

- Give each child a long strip of paper a wider strip means both more drawing surface and a bigger figure to draw.
- The template on the next page printed at A4 size can be used, you can cut around this stencil to make a cardboard template or you can simply draw your own person!
- Fold the paper 'accordion style' approx six times to make a rectangle. Make the folds as even as possible, if you are using the template simply fold along the dotted lines.
- Draw the outline of a child (or use this cut out stencil) in the middle of the rectangle ensuring that the arms and feet at least extend to the folded edges. Use as much space as possible.
- Cut carefully around the child outline. Do not cut along the folds. Unfold the paper to reveal your chain of children!
